THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN IS A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION (next Thursday **15 August**). Mass times at the parish church are 9.15 am and 7pm. Mass times at the Shrine of the Holy Innocents are 6.45 am and Noon on that day.

THE ANNUAL FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION WALK is from the Shrine of the Holy Innocents to Parramatta Cathedral. The pilgrimage begins with the Noon Mass (at the Shrine and celebrated by Bishop Vincent Long, OFM Conv.). All are welcome to walk as we wind along Windsor Road. The stop times are approximately as follows: St. Michael's, 2.30pm; St. Monica's, North Parramatta, 4.30pm; conclude at Parramatta Cathedral, 6pm. Anyone can begin walking from any point along the way. The full walk is 14 km. For more information please contact the parish office.

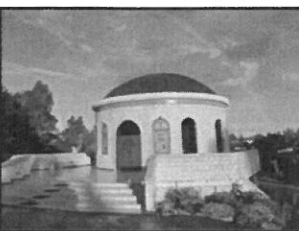
