NOTICE FROM THE CHANCERY REGARDING CORONAVIRUS The spread of coronavirus is being widely reported in the news. This respiratory illness was first detected in Wuhan, Hubei Province in China. The symptoms are similar to those of the common cold and the flu - which includes fever, coughing, headaches, sore throat and, in some cases difficulty in breathing. Common coronavirus are usually passed between humans when a person comes into contact with another infected person. There are currently four confirmed cases of coronavirus in NSW. All cases had travelled to Wuhan or had been in physical contact with a confirmed case in China.

The current advice by the NSW and Australian Department of Health is that like most viruses, the best protection is to:
- Maintain good hand hygiene by frequent hand washing
- Have safe food practices
- Avoid touching your face or mouth until you have washed your hands
- Avoid contact with someone who is showing signs of a respiratory illness.

Only those who have been in contact with a confirmed case of coronavirus or returned travellers from the Hubei Province of China are advised to be isolated in their home for 14 days. If you know of anyone who fits this category, you can provide them with this government advice. Otherwise, the above precautions are the medical advice given by the health authorities for prevention from contracting the virus. Commonwealth and state government agencies have established mechanisms to respond to matters such as this. We will continue to monitor the situation and will provide you with updated information when that is made available.
